Socialization:

Socialization is the key to achieving balance between individual expression and therapeutic needs. Day Habilitation offers memorable and socially appropriate experiences. Our activities foster a sense of self-worth and inclusion.



Educational Opportunities:

We work on language and writing, math and money, computer skills, socialization, safety and other independence skills. There are no limits to the potential skills to be learned! These educational programs provide a great sense of pride for individuals, family and staff.



Personal Care:

We provide supports and supervision in the areas of personal hygiene, eating, communication, mobility, toileting and dressing, as needed, to ensure an individual's ability to experience and participate in community living.



Exercise / Healthy Choices:

Independence and self-reliance include taking care of ourselves. We incorporate exercise, dance, swimming and sports in our daily activities. Our cooking classes teach healthy decisions and choice in food selection and preparation. Health and safety are further emphasized during kitchen and center wide clean up and house keeping skills development.



Recreation & Leisure:

This includes supports identified in the individual's service plan as being therapeutic in nature rather than merely providing a diversion. We work with individuals, families, staff and county representatives to create activities and inspire choice. We strive to create programs that have a purpose to help our individuals grow and experience a wide-variety of opportunities.

Day Habilitation:



PCS programming promotes skill development and training to improve independence and quality of life. Our Day Hab is designed to increase involvement and encourage individual choice in a variety of leisure, recreational and social activities.

Our programs are fun and educational. We focus on small group "Service with a Purpose" activities and teaching methodologies. Our focus enables us to provide specialized individual attention and provide everyone the opportunity to choose activities and be included as part of the planning and design process.

Vocational Development:



Our vocational training services are designed to teach and reinforce concepts related to the work environment including responsibility, attendance, task completion, problem solving, social interaction, motor skill development and safety.

Our centers offer a wide variety of vocational opportunities to empower individual skill development and training, and in many cases, earning a paycheck! Empowering individuals with developmental disabilities to become productive and enabling them to earn a paycheck increases self-confidence and self-esteem further integrating them into a positive social and community environment.

Transportation Services:



One common community employment barrier for individuals with developmental disabilities is reliable and consistent transportation. As part of customer services, PCS offers daily trips, to and from our centers, to community employment and to volunteer opportunities.

We provide safe, reliable, door-to-door transportation, ensuring that every individual can enjoy the most productive life and access every part of their local community. Our vehicles are kept in good operating condition to provide the safest and most economical means of transport from various destinations. Many of our vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts along with the necessary adaptive equipment for people with mobility issues.

Community Integration:



PCS provides many daily and weekly diversified community outings as an opportunity to hone and enhance integration skills.

We visit museums, zoos, restaurants, cultural centers and sporting events. We also go shopping, bowling and attend fairs and festivals. The possibilities are endless!

We work with individual preferences and everyone is included in community trip planning. Activity planning provides an opportunity to engage, learn, play and live life more fully.

Person Specific Programming:

Independence and learning remain important throughout every individual's life experience. The purpose of our training / skill development focuses on each person's opportunity for individual / small group specific learning.

At the individual's annual meeting, we collaborate with the individual, their family and other team members to isolate specific areas of concentration to enhance independence, education, learning and growth.

Goals and outcomes are developed and implementation is delivered and documented based on the frequency of the identified goals. This time provides the one-to-one support and learning required for skills retention, expanding independence, and continued growth.
